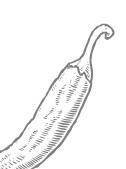

Market updates

Harvest has been completed and material from cold storage has started to arrive into market.

Delayed onset of South West monsoon in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is likely to impact farmer's sowing plans.

High price realization in Chilli likely to prompt a shift from Cotton and Pulses cultivation.

Due to higher price realization for chilli, many farmers, have started booking seeds quite early, anticipating a shortage of seed supplies in July and August.

Export of whole chillies to Bangladesh and China for the month of June remains stable at 15 Kilo tonnes. However first half of 2023 (205 Kilo tonnes) has seen almost 50% increase compared to same period last year (125 Kilo tonnes).

Market updates

In India, harvest has been completed and material from cold storage has started to arrive.

High color varieties remain priced at a premium.

With the delayed arrival of the South West monsoon, farmers in Karnataka are eagerly anticipating sufficient rainfall to make plans for sowing their crops.

As the season neared its end, the quality of the crop has declined.

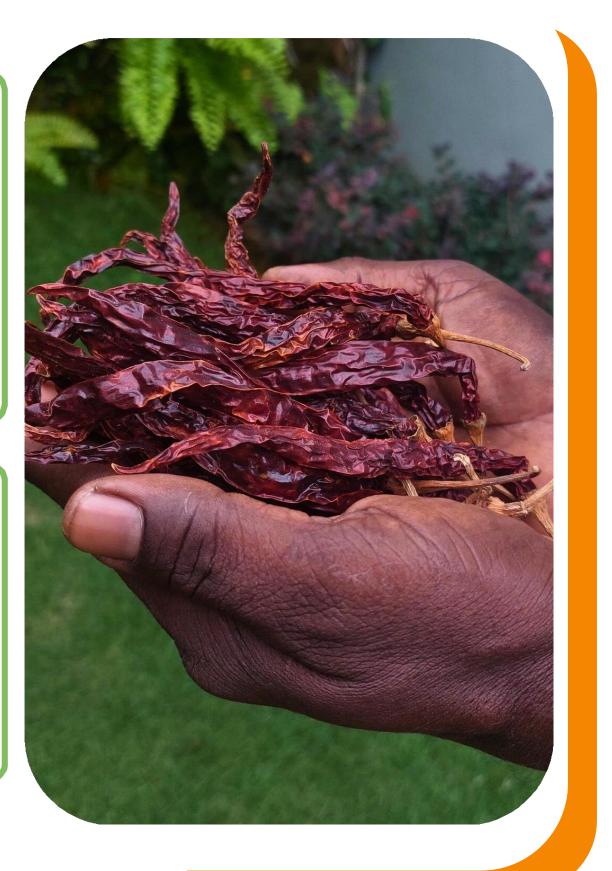
In China, the fluctuation of the local currency relative to the US dollar has resulted in lower prices for exports.

Market updates

The demand for turmeric experienced a surge last month as the season neared its end.

Speculative stocking, and rainfall deficits in growing regions led to price increase.

The futures price for turmeric has increased by >30% through the month June.

Sowing is continuing in some parts of central and south India and is expected to continue till July end. Acreage for farming is expected to decrease in certain pockets, due to low prices of crop.

Higher prices has triggered movement of high color turmeric from south to Central India.

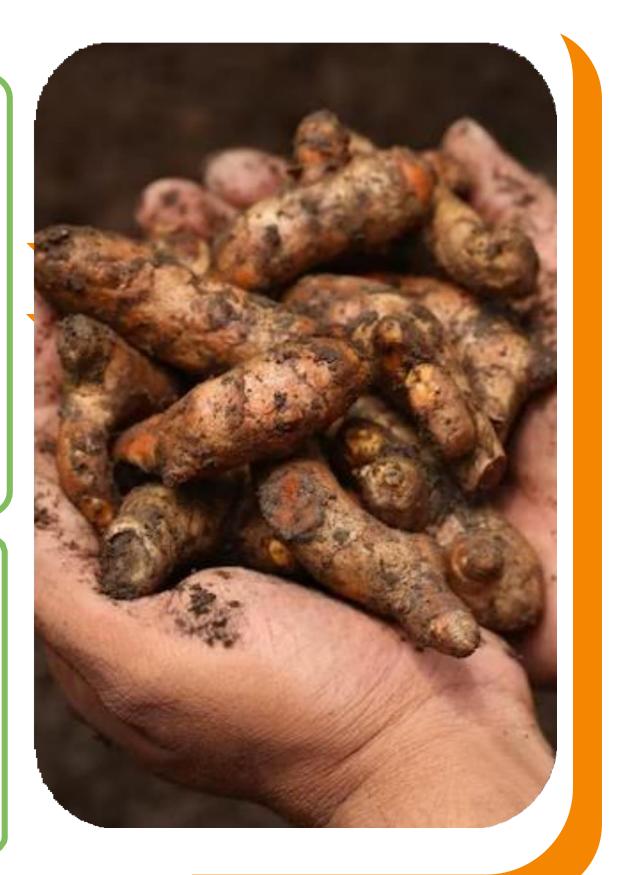
Rainfall deficit in most of the growing areas in India

Market updates

Vietnam exported a total of 152K MT of Black pepper in comparison to 125K MT in 2022 in similar period. China continues to be major buyer, however there was slump in demand in June.

In Sri Lanka, prices have come down and expected to remain stable. Currency fluctuations, including a 4% drop in the value of the LKR vs. USD at the end of June compared to the previous week, has played a major role in the decrease in prices.

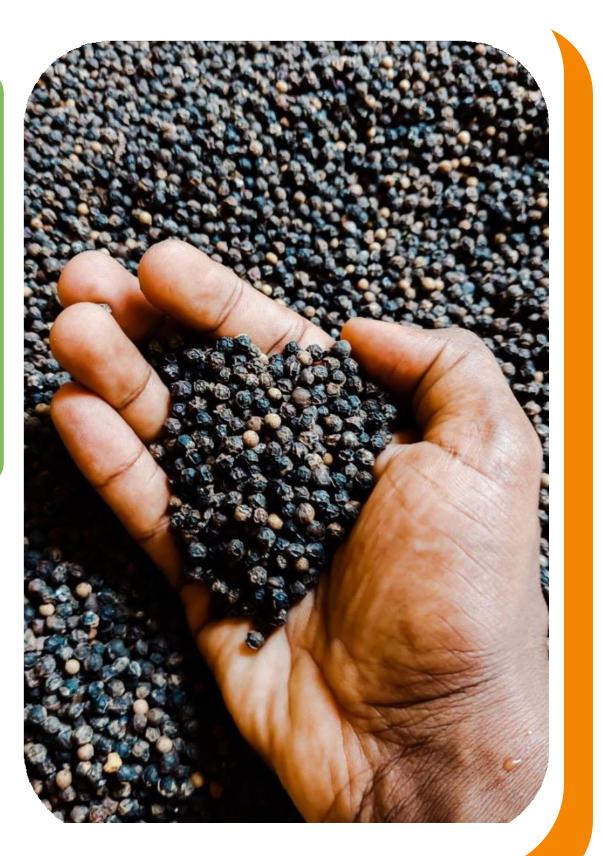
Brazil market has opened at lower price. Harvest has started at North and is expected to commence soon at South.

Indonesia stocks arrival has commenced. However there is a shortage expected due to erratic weather patterns. Indonesia domestic and export prices were stable.

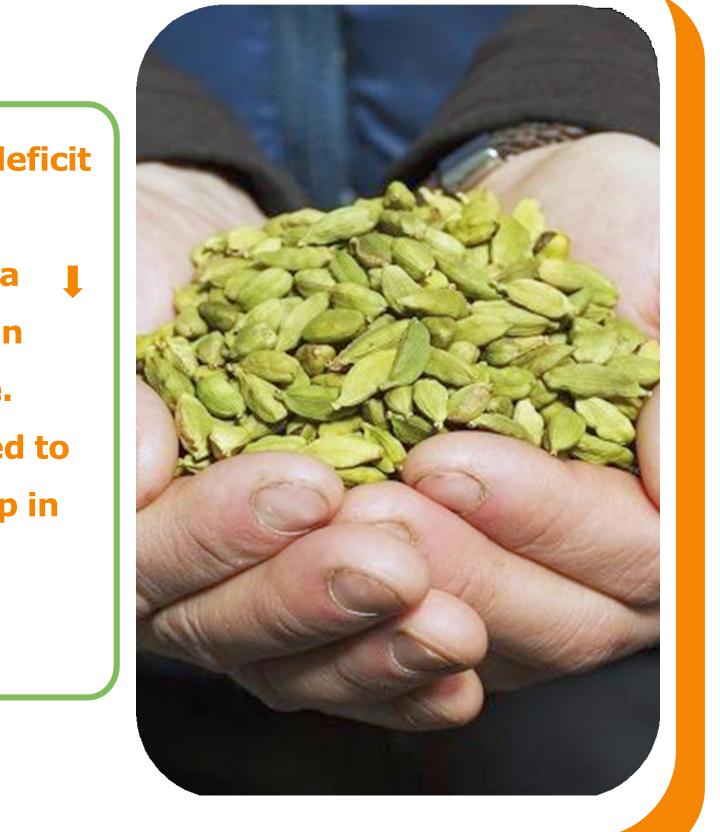
The continuous rainfall indicates a positive trend for crop growth, but precise predictions are still challenging due to the unpredictable nature of climatic conditions.

The harvest season has commenced and fresh crops have entered the market.

Prices have seen a dip by around 10% vs. last month, currently at USD 1.1/kg.

The demand remains stable.

With favorable climatic conditions prevailing after sowing, the yield has been high with no crop damage.

The carry forward stock is limited.

Market updates

Europe – Sowing has been completed, and we anticipate the arrival of new crops to start from August.

India - Due to low prices, domestic demand increased.

Even though harvest was completed by April, less than 80% of the crop has made its way into the market. The fall in prices over last many months have resulted in hesitation from farmers to sell their product. Farmers are holding stock expecting prices to increase soon.

The prices for Indian **Coriander has** marginally increased over last month and currently trading at USD

Market updates

India Cumin – Crop arrival is mainly from North and West India. Compared to same period last year, prices have almost doubled and currently trading at USD 6.5/kg.

The unpredictable weather patterns this year have impacted farmer sentiments, resulting in delayed sowing and a reduction in acreage due to alternating crops. The combination of an extreme cold wave in January, early heatwaves in February, and unseasonal rainfall in March has contributed to a lower yield in crop.

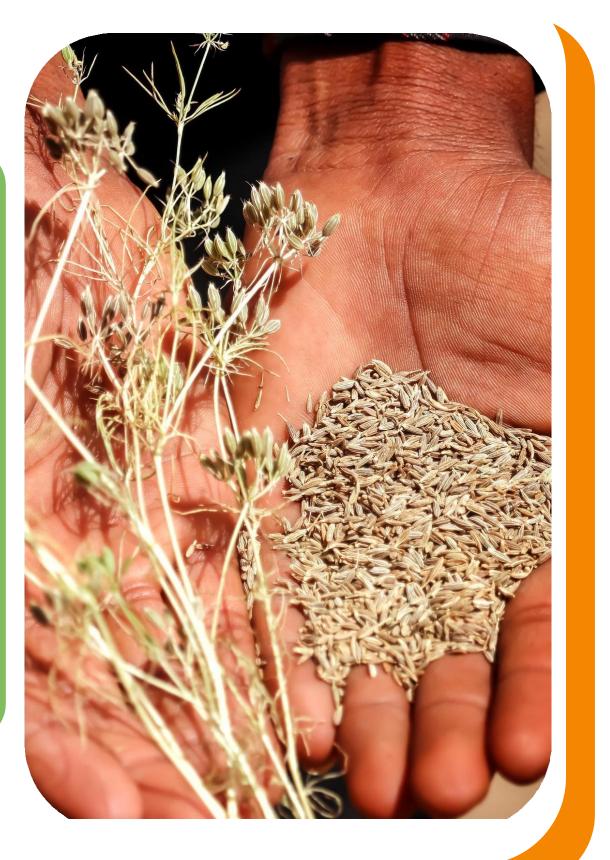
The **Syrian cumin** have started arriving in the markets. The prices have remained stable. We expect the cumin prices to remain at high levels for the remaining year.

There is **limited availability of IPM grade cumin** and the prices for same has increased.

India Fennel – Crop arrival has been limited.

Prices are expected to increase by around 20% and currently trading at USD 3.6/kg.

Egyptian fennel also witnessed a price increase of 5% from last month, currently trading at around USD 6.0/kg.
