Market updates

Harvest season has extended till 3rd picking (limited stock) in May since there was a good crop. However there is considerable difference in size and capsaicin levels compared to 1st and 2nd pickings. Some markets were shut at Andhra Pradesh(AP) and Telengana however some markets at Warangal and Khammam have reopened.

Material from cold storage has also started to arrive. Quality of material from farm is lower than what we saw in the last 2 months. Arrival of materials may get affected on commencement of South west monsoon soon to hit AP and Telengana.

Unlike last year, challenges of pest infestation has been better controlled this year. **IPM grade chilli availability is low**. So expected to be at a premium. With reasonable quantity available in cold storage, availability during off season is also possible.

Farmers are hopeful for a similar or better season next year which has pushed demand for seeds.

Export of whole chillies to Bangladesh and China remains stable.

Market updates

Major Paprika markets from **India** are **witnessing a drop** in arrival of material since season has ended.

Availability of delux variety has come down.

Unlike last year, challenges of pest infestation has been better controlled this year.

High color varieties continue to demand high prices.

In China, unprecedented snow fall in May, led to crop availability being low and prices increase.

Byadagi market witnessed a drop in arrivals with around 30,000 Bags / day compared to peak arrivals of 280,000 bags / day. **Cold Storages this year**

Market updates

Stock has started to arrive in major markets in central and south India.

In some parts of central and south India, sowing for next season is almost nearing completion. And it is expected to continue till July end.

In some pockets, acreage for farming is likely to see a dip due to lower prices.

Industries relying on high color curcumin had to a pay a premium on account of unseasonal rains in central India region.

Prices have been stable over sometime.

There is sufficient availability of carry forward stock.

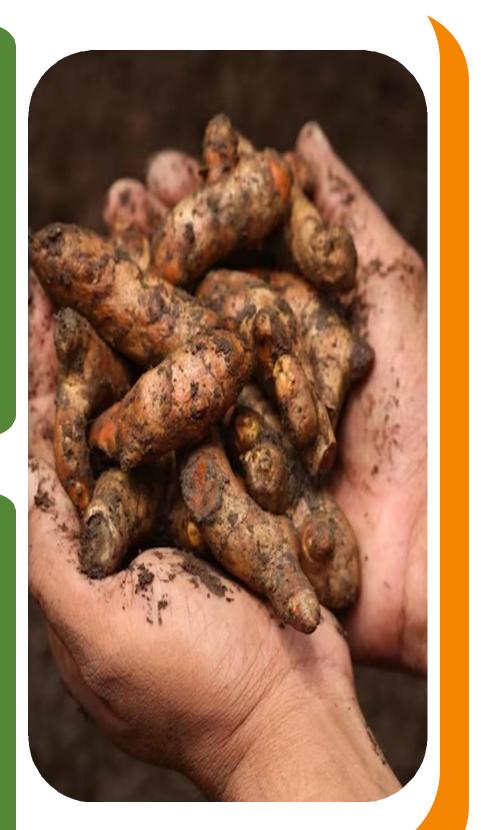

Market updates

Harvesting completed at Vietnam. Carry forward stocks remain at moderate level.

In Sri Lanka, due to the lower price difference between bold pepper and light berries , farmers prefer to pick as bold pepper. Hence **arrival of light berries is low. Volatility in prices due to LKR, USD fluctuation is observed.** Prices are lower than last year.

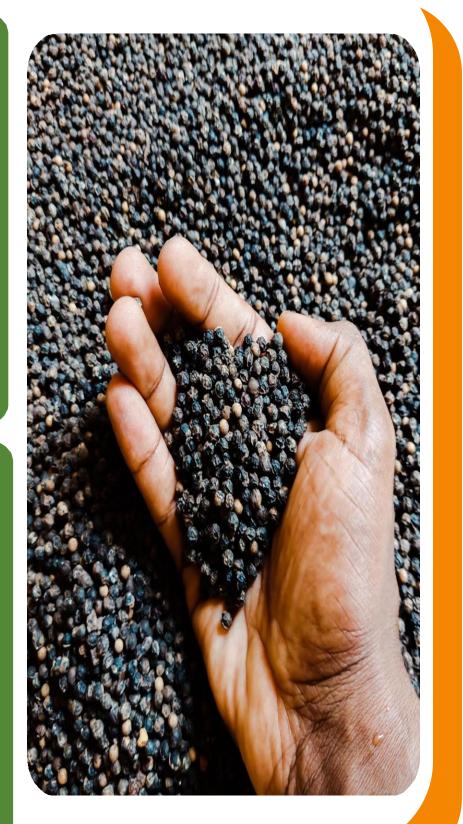
Brazilian stocks are expected to arrive in July. Brazilian prices are likely to impact Vietnam prices.

Indonesia pepper harvest will commence in June. However there is a shortage expected due to weather.

Sudden high volume orders from China pushed Vietnam prices up by 9-10%

Sri Lanka materials have started to arrive. However crop output is 20% lower compared to last Vear.

Market updates

High demand for Indian ginger led to prices getting doubled and currently trading at USD 1.9 per Kg.

Prices for green ginger has been much more volatile and prices have gone by by almost 3 times, currently trading at USD 1.5 per Kg. New crop sowing for next season has started. Area of cultivation expected to increase due to demand.

Nigerian ginger harvest has been completed and the material currently traded is from carry forward stocks, which is lower than last year. High prices of Indian ginger resulted in higher demand for Nigerian ginger.

There is no IPM grade or organic ginger availability currently in market.

Ginger prices has

Market updates

New crop arrivals have already started. And likely to continue to September.

We are expecting around 6500 MT of arrival this year which is 35% drop from last year arrivals.

Almost 90% of domestic and export demand will be met by this stock.

Carry forward stock will be very low.

Prices will go up in Aug and Sep.

Due to increase in sowing of wheat & maize last year, there was a drastic fall in crop sown area for celery by 35%

Market updates

Europe Coriander - Crop sowing is ongoing in major growing regions such as Russia, Ukraine, Bulgaria and Romania.

The Russo – Ukrainian war has an impact on the supply of the crop. Carry forward stocks are expected to remain low.

India Coriander production has increased compared to last year - due to increase in cultivation area by almost double.

Around 60% of the crop has arrived into the market. The fall in prices have resulted in hesitation from farmers to sell their product.

The prices have stabilized over the last month,

after witnessing a steep

decline over the past few



months.

Market updates

India Cumin – arrivals have started in major growing areas like Gujarat & Rajasthan. Crop is expected to be short this year.

Unexpected rains in Feb had damaged some of the crop.

Export demand, short arrivals and low carry forward stocks have kept the prices very high.

Total supply from India expected to be 370-400 K M.T.

Cumin from Syria & Turkey - Harvesting is expected to start in June.

Carry forward stocks will get built up.

Prices of Turkish & Syrian cumin are expected to come down with commencement of material arrivals in July & August.

There is limited availability of IPM grade cumin and the prices for same has increased.

India Fennel - Crop has arrived from major markets Gujarat, MP and UP. Due to lower crop last year , the carry forward stock is limited. The **rains in March** which occurred during the harvesting period has **resulted** in quality deterioration of new crop.

The continuous demand in Q1 2023 along with limited carry forward stock has pushed the prices up.

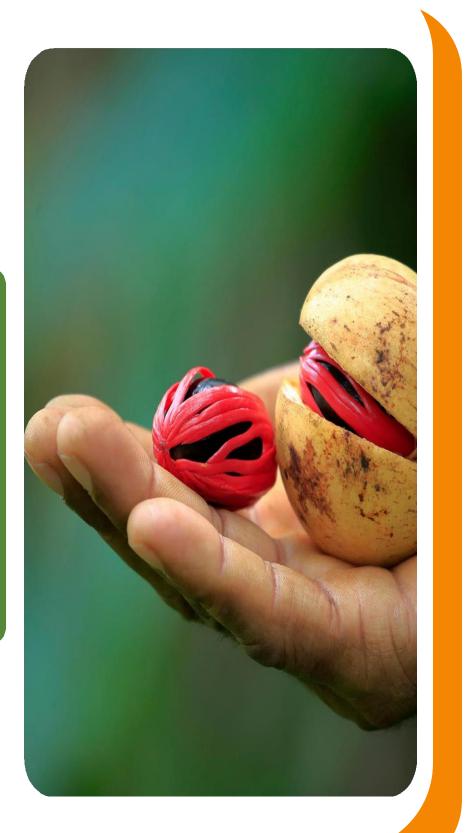
Market updates

India – Total production is estimated to be same as in last year. Climate was supportive of crop in recent months.

Indonesia - The **supply of raw materials is continuous through the year,** because different regions have different harvesting periods.

Aggressive buying of materials from China has kept the prices high
